Box Tops Competition:

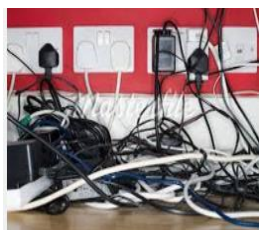
