The **3/4 girls basketball** team had a great victory against St. Mike's and lost a nail biter to St. Joan of Arc by two points!

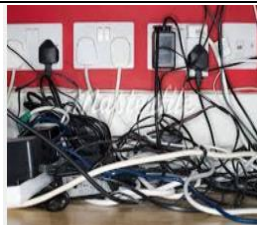
Bake Sale to benefit 7th/8th Grade Washington, D.C. trip
