## Ski Club Begins January 8th!



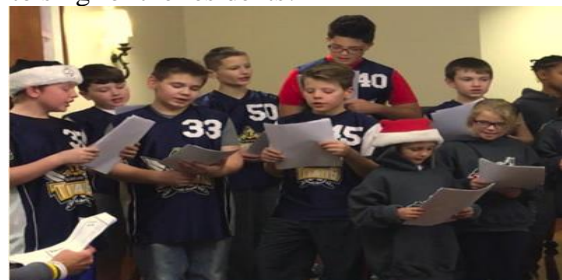
