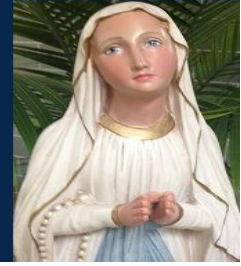

- \*Car wash accessories

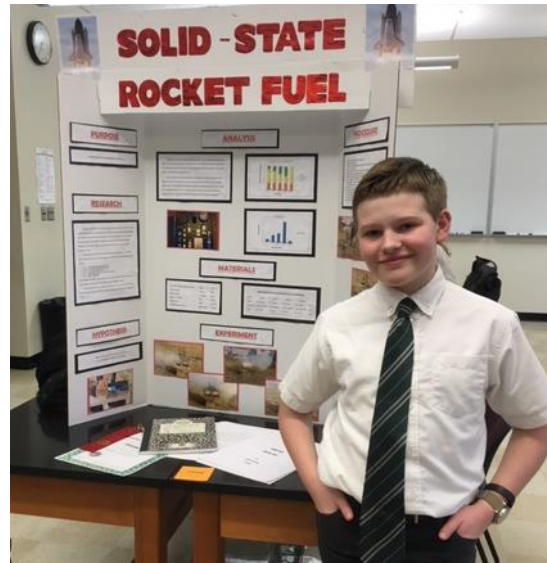
### **Reverse Raffle Rally**

# SUPER SCIENCE !




## St. Mary to host 7<sup>th</sup> / 8<sup>th</sup> Dance

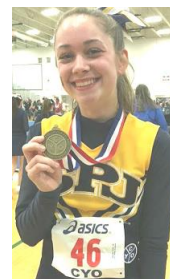

### **SPJ at the Scripps Spelling Bee and Power of the Pen**

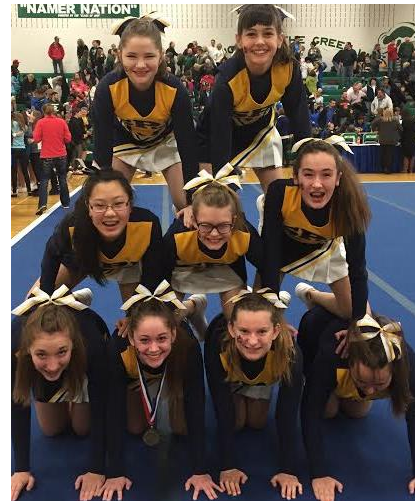
