

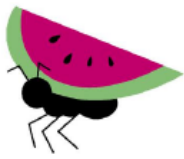

SPJ Alumni to Sing National Anthem

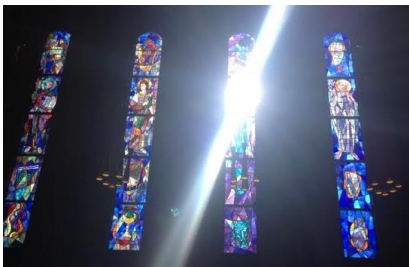
